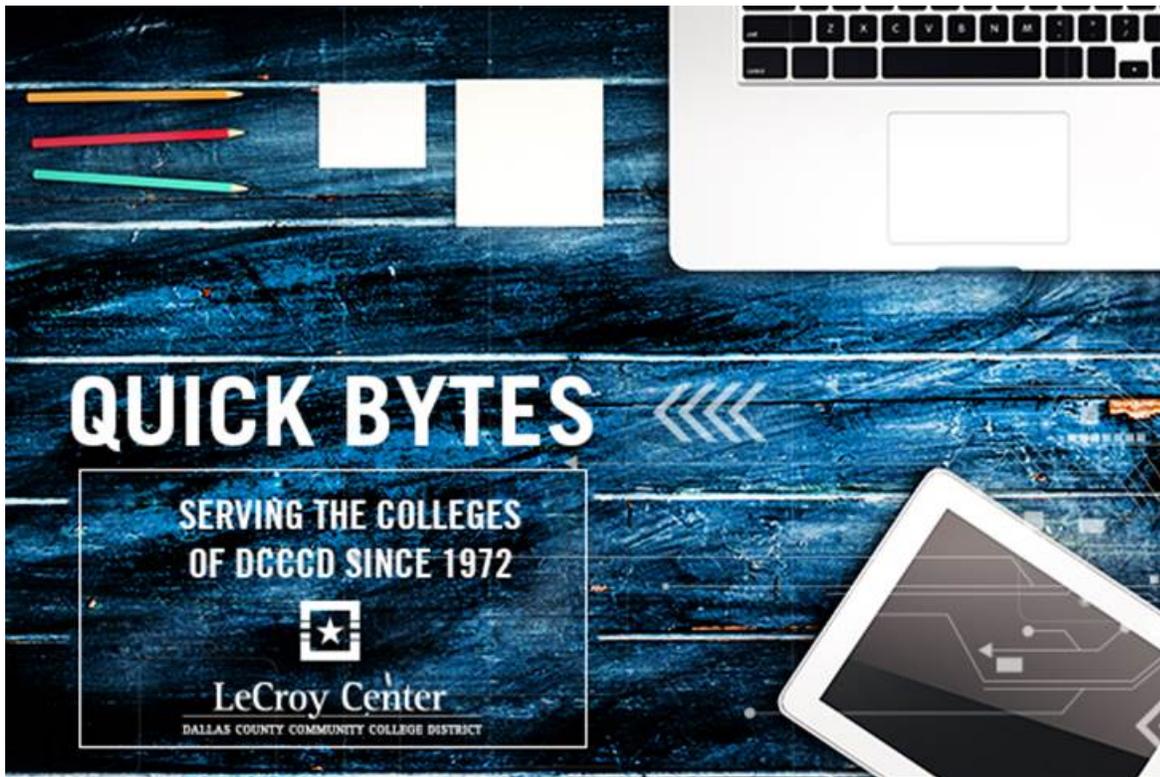

New Rules for Out-of-State Online Students

States have long had the authority to regulate institutions offering education within the state's boundaries, regardless of the modality used (face-to-face, online). There is now an approval process, State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (SARA), which will require institutions to be approved before enrolling students from out-of-state. This is all part of new consumer protection guidelines for online out-of-state students. The United States Department of Education (USDOE) requires that institutions comply with any applicable state approval or licensure requirements in each state to which online instruction is delivered. As a result all colleges must be authorized to deliver online instruction prior to allowing students from those states to enroll.

Dallas Colleges Online and the DCCCD can accept enrollments from students residing in these SARA states.

Textbook-Free Courses Available: Students Save up to \$500

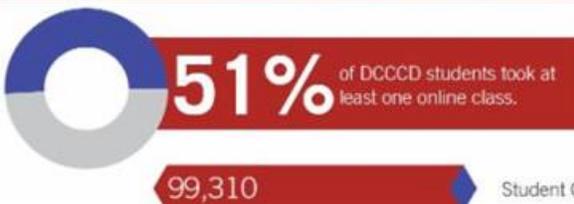

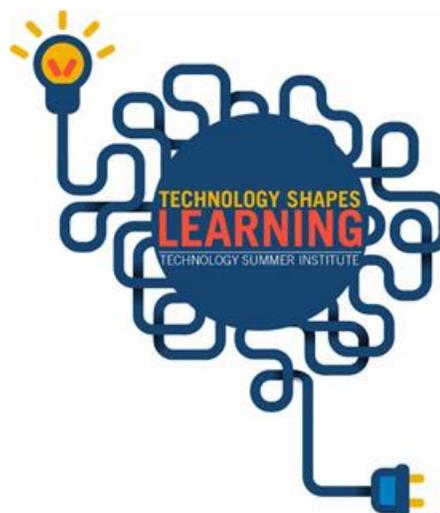

Finding Value in a Quality Scorecard

Measuring quality in online education can be elusive and complex at times. Educators continue to seek out ideal learning environments and share effective practices for advancing quality.

Recently the LeCroy Center and the DCCCD selected the Online Learning Consortium (OLC) Scorecard to support and simplify the steps needed to identify, measure and quantify elements of quality within the online programs. The process will help the team of district faculty, administrators and staff to apply metrics, uncover and evaluate quality indicators in key categories, and consider thoughtful recommendations for implementation. In addition, the scorecard has a cross-walk tied to SACS standards.



Chancellor May and senior DCCCD leadership have agreed to adopt a district-wide network model in which we work together to leverage resources, to provide more personalized services, and to scale up our ability to serve students.

Transitioning away from seat time, in favor of a structure that allows students to receive college credit for work earned is part of a new Fast Track Supervisory Certificate Program the LeCroy Center is developing with Cedar Valley College and North Lake College. Developed with Competency Based Education (CBE) strategies, the program includes Cooperative Work Experience-- earning college credit for on-the-job experience.

The CBE Supervisor Certificate is 100% online and has six 8-week courses. Students who take two classes at a time, can complete the program in 24 weeks. Available Summer 2016.
